The primary role of this position is to support the implementation of data collection activities in the relevant region in Namibia. This position will be based at selected health facilities and will collect data as per study protocol using a tablet.

REQUIRED MINIMUM EDUCATION:

- Grade 12 certificate.

REQUIRED MINIMUM (relevant) WORK EXPERIENCE:

- Experience in research or data collection.
- Reside within the selected health facility catchment area.
- Knowledge of the area and language spoken in that area.
- Fluent spoken and written English.
- Computer and tablet skills.
- Open-mindedness and respect for cultural diversity.
- Very strong attention to detail and organizational skills, including following step-by-step instructions.

KEY PERFORMANCE AREAS (Roles and responsibilities):

1. Data collection

- Attend the training of Data Collectors.
- Explain the purpose of the study to study participants.
- Obtain consent and conduct interviews using a tablet.
- Carry out data collection for both the formative assessment and mixed-methods assessment.

2. Administration and logistical support

- Work closely with field team members to ensure that study is appropriately supported.
- Ensure that there are adequate and appropriate equipment and supplies to complete study activities.

3. Performing any other duties

- Performing any tasks assigned by the Supervisor.
